- 299B-03 Both players were plagued early with difficult humid conditions. Parica adjusted better and won going away.
- 299B-04 In the first match, whatever could go wrong did for Canadian champion Chris Orme. As a result, Daulton was never threatened as he routed Orme 11-1.
In match number two, Deuel freewheeled as Souquet never got going.
- 299B-05 In part one, after a difficult start, Schmidt took charge and controlled the rest of the match.
In part two, Luc's fast play was great entertainment as Hopkins' methodical style was intriguing.
Salvas took advantage of several unforced errors.
- 299B-06 Rob Saez in his Accu-Stats' debut match outlasted Garcia with a respectable performance.
- * 299B-07 Reyes kept control throughout the entire match clearly playing better than Daulton.
- * 299B-08 The match was much closer than the score indicated. Rodney and Earl both played quite well, but the rolls did not go Morris' way.
- 299B-09 Another Accu-Stats debut and Thorsten Hohmann showed ample proof why he will always be a threat. Steady, deliberate, and consistent play is his trademark.
- * 299B-10 One of the most enjoyable matches to date. Although Immonen played well, Deuel stole the show with his extraordinary pocketing skills.
- * 299B-11 Great play by both players! Owen's come from behind victory won him the hot seat and it became clear that he could take it all.
- 299B-12 Hohmann continued with his trademark play, a joy to watch. Feijen played well but just couldn't keep up.
- * 299B-13 In one of the most memorable finals for Accu-Stats, Gabe Owen never looked back as he played near flawlessly never giving Hohmann a chance to compete. With his two .900's in his only two appearances in front of the cameras, Gabe will be one to contend with for years to come.
